

The Sununu Place by Randal Jett and Matt Samet

The following guide is reproduced with permission from the authors. The text and photos are from Matt and Randal's excellent but out of print "Sport Climbing in New Mexico".

Warning: Rock climbing is a potentially dangerous sport. The author's opinions regarding the following climbs are intended to serve only as guidelines. It is the responsibility of each user of this guide to determine when our suggestions should be disregarded in favor of a more suitable approach. Helmets are advised. You are responsible for your own actions.

Some climbs in this guide may be equipped with cold shut anchors. These anchors are intended for lowering after a lead only. **DO NOT BELAY ON OR TOP-OUT OVER OPEN COLD SHUT ANCHORS.** Serious injury or death may occur if this warning is ignored.

This small crag is located 30 yards south of "Below the Old New Place", and is also directly below "The Old New Place". To get to "Sununu Place" from NM state road 4, turn south on Rover Blvd. After about 200 yards, take a left on Meadow Lane. Park near 719 Meadow Lane, being careful not to block mailboxes or driveways (several residents have complained in the past). Take the public access trail between 719 and 721 Meadow Lane.

"Below the "Old New Place" is almost straight out, but veer left (north) somewhat, and pass by the "The Old New Place" on the south end at a dip in the mesa rim. "Below the "Old New Place" is BELOW the "The Old New Place," as is the "Sununu Place". The descent is also on the south.

This small crag is located thirty yards south of **Below The Old New Place**. It is also directly below **The Old New Place**.

****1 Barbara's Midnight Missile 10c/d**

A short face with three bolts to a chain anchor. At present, this route has been stripped of it's hangers by some worthless steamy pile.

FA: Burns, Fehlau

***2 Bush Whacker 5.9+**

A three bolt hangerless face to the same anchors as for #1.
