

## Spearhead Syke's Sickle III, 5.10

Approach: Drive to Bear Lake parking lot, then hike the trail to Glacier Junction. Follow well-signed trail to Mills Lake, then continue S. to Black Lake. Hike steeper ad hoc trail up creek to E., then S. to basin under peak. 7 miles, 3-6 hours.

1 set wired nuts, small to medium 1 set active cams, smallest to 3" (if not a 5.10 leader, add medium 4" active cam optional for roof 12" slings or quick-draws (4)

From summit, hike down loose class 2 slopes to the west. Can traverse easily to the base of the route if you left anything there. Escape is possible from anywhere below the roof using fixed rap

class 2 to summit (200')North Ridge overhanging flake E 120' 5.5-5.7 cracks & flakes (several options) good bolt 20' X out (hidden from stance) Chockstones 5.7+ face, R 100 5.10 chimney 3" Cam at lip 5.9+lieback classic lieback flake! 5.7 awkward chimney - exit 160' right before top, or place pro high and downclimb to protect face traverse (5.8).
